Treasurers Report (Ramon Gavarrete)

NEW BUSINESS

Proposed Budget/Budget Committee Report (Ramon) [1:54]

Budget committee met 2 weeks ago after two postponements. Provided proposed budget for 2013. Proposed budget based on 2012 actual and expected expenses as much as possible. Compared to 2010 expenditures.

Budget year based on calendar year. Is it appropriate to formally adopt budget year? Need to make a decision. May be appropriate to formally adopt. No need to adopt at this time, review and adopt in November. Report at this time only.

Merrill Lynch Investment Account (Ramon Gavarrete) [1:50]

Financial investment account statement shows losses. In 2011, loss was \$426.31. including an annual fee of \$300. Losses in 2012 of \$107.64, does not include fee. Recommendation (Ramon Gavarrete) is to dissolve investment account (cash in) and move to checking account and/or money market account. Recommendation (John Goodknight) to move to money market and receive some interest.

Motion: Close account and move to checking and/or money market (Fred Schneider, Ramon Gavarrete). Judy will review which checking or money market, will review in November, Passed.

Dues Increase/Budget Committee Report (Ramon Gavarrete) [1:45]

Discussion on fees. Membership category in constitution. Do not need to address Constitution as it only deals with membership class, fees/dues based on status. Membership fee increase justification (see graphics). June decision to go from \$50 to \$75, corporate to \$125. Budget committee recommends no additional increase above June 2012 decision, based on top graphic.

Membership (John Goodknight) [1:39]

New Application for new fees drafted. Significant new fee options based on June decision - \$75 for public employees, \$125 for non-public employees. Added choice for first year FACERS fee waiver. NACE fee changes to \$150. Beginning October 1. fees as stated above with definitions of membership types - public (government employees and state agencies, education) and non-public employees. Membership to NACE is affiliated with FACER and membership is strongly recommended.

Attempting to clarify fee waiver upon request for remainder of membership fee. Former action was to include everyone (not just government employees) but was not published. Recommend that we waive fee from application date to end of FACERS membership year; the next dues would need to be paid by end of calendar year.

Recommendations related to membership and dues:

Motion. Maintain membership list on UF's web server through John Goodknight, instead of moving from Treasurer to Treasurer. Motion (Ramon Gavarrete, Scott Cottrell) Passed.

Motion. Adopt T-Squared system for email distribution. Motion (Ramon Gavarrete, Scott Cottrell) Passed.

Motion. Generate personalized invoice from membership database. Include followup invoicing schedule. Continue invoicing for two years. Motion (Scott Cottrell, Judy Grim) Passed

Motion. Fee waiver guidelines allow no fees for balance of year waiver is granted. Payment required by first of the year for the year following the year of application. Objective to recruit, simplify, apply consistently. First year of public employees, all rights, etc. next payment due of next January. Payment received in October are also applied to next calendar year. Motion (Ramon Gavarrete, Chris Mora) Passed

Motion, All corporate members will not be eligible for fee waiver. Any payments after October 1 is credited applicant membership for those three months and next calendar year. Motion (Ramon Gavarrete, Fred Schneider) Passed

Website (John Goodknight) [0:47]

Members only section is a filing system for FACERS records. See document F. Each bullet is essentially a file cabinet. Questions about where the founding documents are located now. Amy Blaida will research.

Three key pages: scholarship awards, business items and operating procedures. Business items includes a section for meeting minutes, would like to include information that provides appropriate records, decisions. Treasures reports and budgets also have a page.

Under the operating procedures section, looking for the articles of incorporation.
