EDC Exchanges for Market-Ready Technologies - FREE NEW

The Federal Highway Administration's Every Day Counts (EDC) Initiative is taking information sharing to the next level. In partnership with the Florida Transportation Technology Transfer Center and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) will begin hosting a series of dynamic peer exchanges called the "EDC Exchange". The nationally broadcasted learning sessions will allow participants to hear from national subject matter experts about "market-ready" EDC technologies. Participants will also exchange information locally about effective project development and delivery practices for immediate in their programs. Florida is one of the many states hosting locations for the interactive sessions.

Although this is a broadcast session, only 3 locations per exchange are scheduled for Florida; Tallahassee, Ocoee, and Davie. You must register and receive a confirmation to attend any session. Space is very limited.
