



FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND JOBS ACT (IIJA, H.R. 3684)

- 'Bipartisan' Infrastructure Spending that reauthorizes the Federal Surface Transportation Act
- Provides \$973 billion in funding over a 5-year period (FFY 2022 – FFY 2026)
- Includes over \$550 billion in *new* infrastructure spending.

Florida Specific Details

- Increases funding for core highway funding programs by \$13.5 billion.
- Missed opportunity in
 bridge funds and updating to 2010 census.



- Improve community relations.




