#### **I-275 Pinellas Corridor**

FDOT

- Design Bid Build procurements
- Widening for two buffer separated express lanes in each direction north of I-375
- Wide outside shoulders for transit accommodations
- Lane continuity improvements
- Noise barriers: ~6 miles
- ROW acquisition: 2 parcels



Length: 7.5 miles

Design: \$7.2 Million (FY 24)

ROW: \$2.5 Million (FY 22)

Construction Estimate: \$340 Million

Letting: FY 25 (Moving Florida Forward)

Final approvals – Spring 2024

Length: 2 miles

Design: \$12 Million (FY 24)

ROW: \$20 Million (not currently funded)

Construction Estimate: \$146 Million

Letting: TBD

Final approvals – Spring 2024

Length: 4.5 Miles

Design: \$7.1 Million (FY 25)

ROW: No ROW anticipated

Construction Estimate: \$111 Million

Letting: TBD

- Asphalt Paving (85% complete)


#### **Upcoming Work**

- Final traffic shifts












#### **Howard Frankland Bridge**











- 96% of pilings are complete
- 88% of footings are complete
- 87% of columns are complete
- 78% of caps are complete
- 836 beams have been placed
- 53 of 113 Light Rail Transit (LRT) decks have been placed
- 23 Non-LRT decks have been placed



**Howard Frankland Bridge approach to Westshore** 






- Managed lanes connecting to the Veterans Expressway, Courtney Campbell Causeway, Howard Frankland Bridge, and TIA
- 3 local streets reconnected at I-275
- Shared use path/trail and aesthetic treatments throughout the project
- Construction anticipated to begin in 2024

# Westshore Interchange and Early Works










- Multiple projects completing improvements to facilitate mobility during construction
- Improvements will enhance traffic operations on the local street network

Traffic and Environmental updates are underway and should be completed late 2023.

#### **Preliminary Construction Activities**

Micro-tunneling operations have begun along the east side of I-275 in advance of major construction activities beginning in late 2023.

#### **Construction Progress**

- 100% of gravity walls constructed
- 84% of Mechanically Stabilized Earth (MSE) walls constructed
- 91% of bridge decks widened
- 44% of noise barrier walls constructed
- 88% of sign structures installed
- 50% of drainage installed
- 24% of sidewalks completed

# **Other Major Projects**



#### US 19 from SR 580 to N of CR 95 (Pinellas)



**Construction Began: April 2023 Construction Complete: 2029** 

- Modifying the existing 6-lane divided highway to a 6-lane controlled access roadway with one-way frontage roads in both directions in Pinellas County.
- New interchanges will be added just north of Boy Scout Road and at SR 586 (Curlew Road).
- Pedestrian underpass will be added between Evans Road and Republic Drive and a pedestrian bridge over US 19 is being constructed at Northside Drive.








# I-4 Florida's Regional Advanced Mobility Elements (FRAME)




