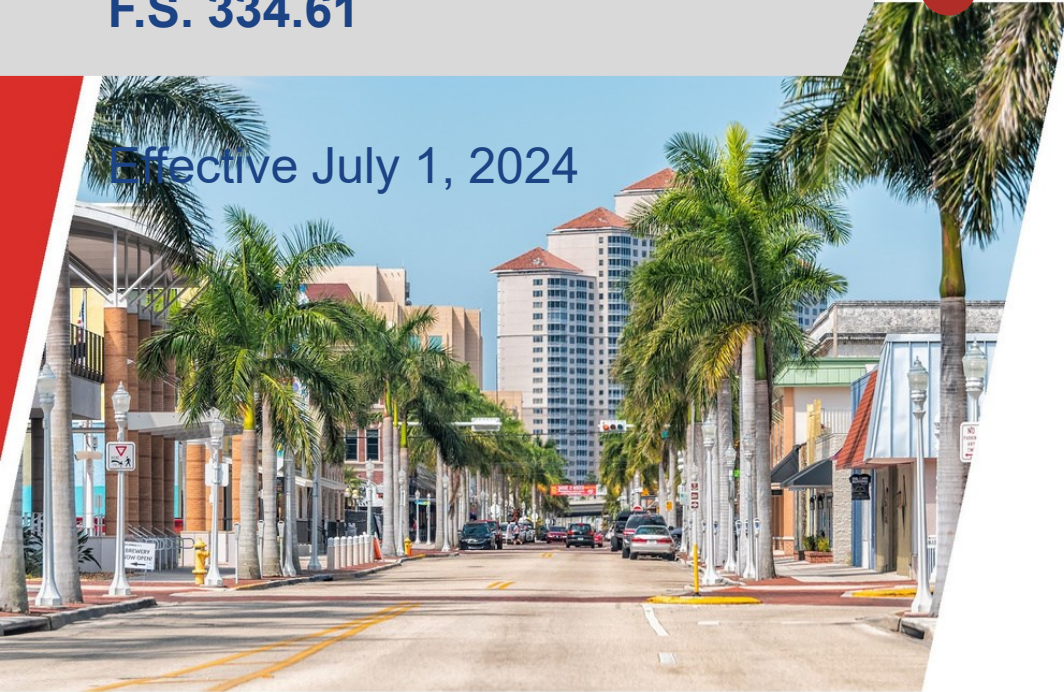

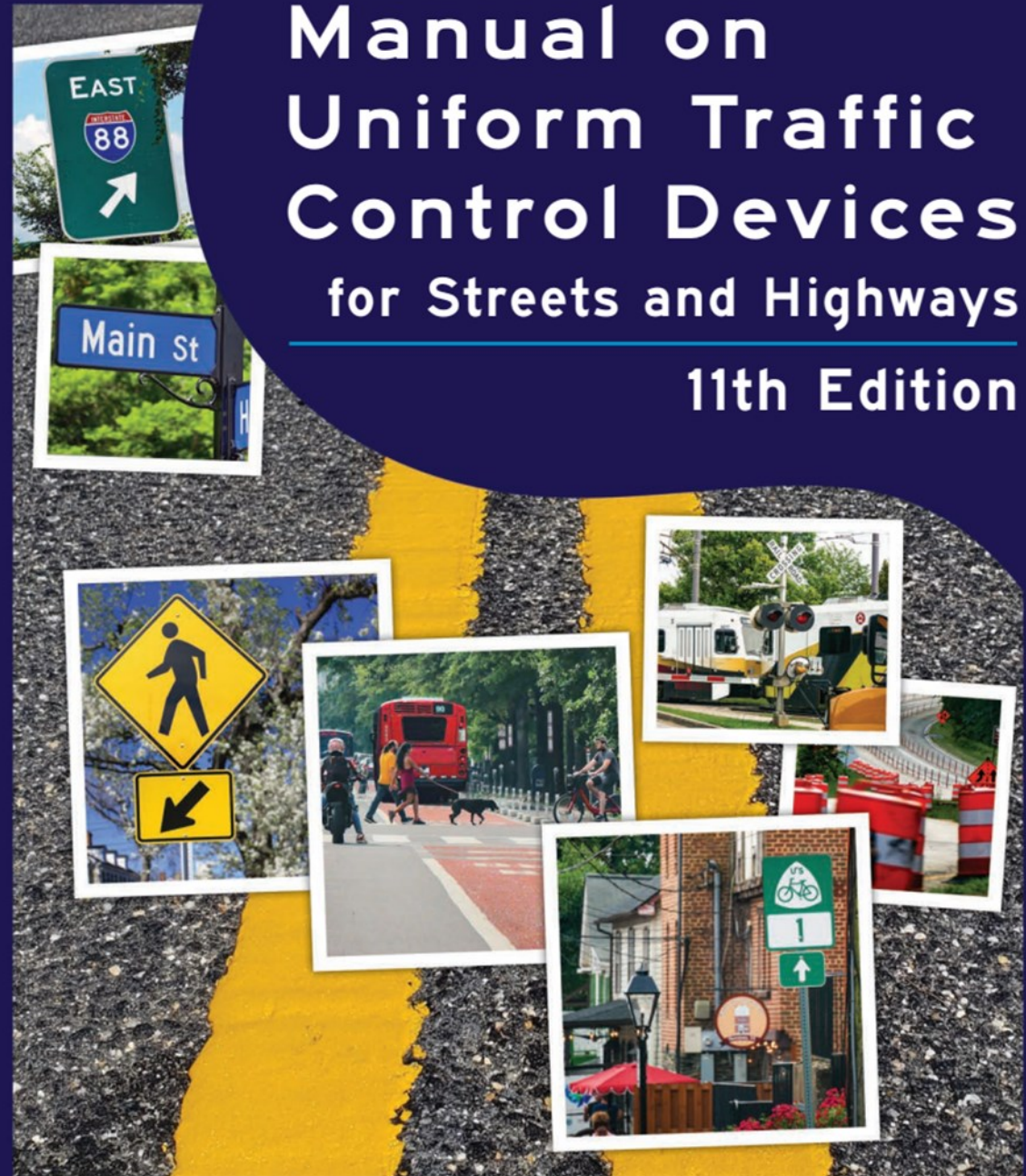

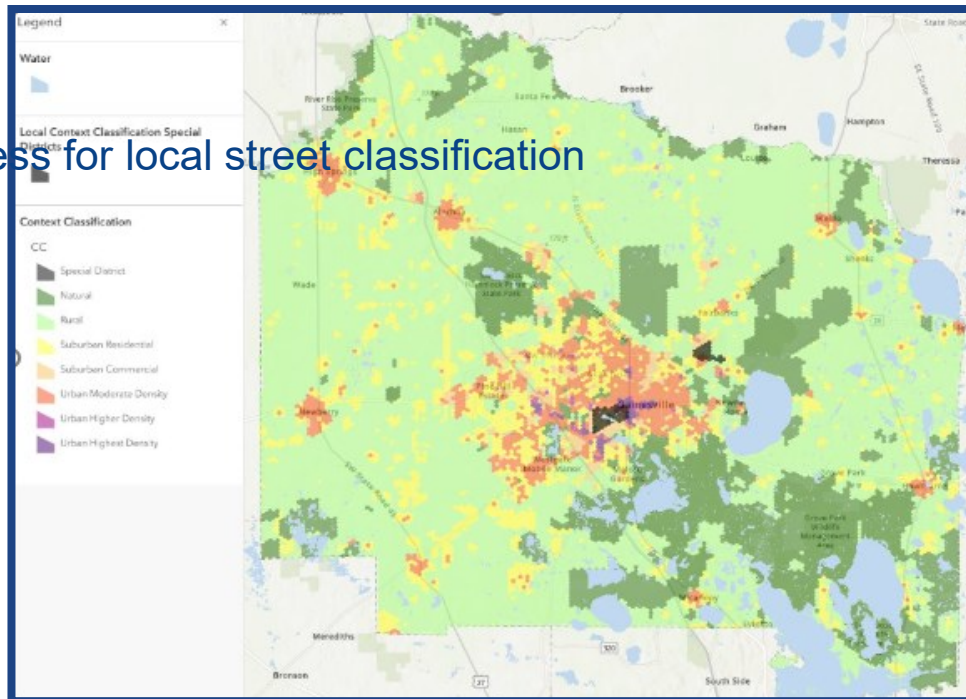

GAP SCAT TOOL

The new SCAT Tool is now available for local agencies to create and submit SCAT approvals directly in the GAP System.

The Responsible Charge for each agency will need to identify personnel (name/email) to be granted the necessary permissions in GAP to create and manage submissions by emailing @CO-Local Programs using subject line SCAT TOOL. If they do not already have an account in GAP one will need to be created for them before permissions can be given.*All questions related to the SCAT Tool application, process or issues will need to be sent to the CO-SCAT@dot.state.fl.us email for assistance.**

Once permissions are given a notification email with instructions and user manual will be sent



State & Federal Updates

Recent Legislation Signed Into Law:

- **HB 1209 – Alternative Advance Payment for RAO Communities**
- **HB 287 – LAP Division 1 Spec consolidation and addition of contingency amounts in contracts.**
- **HB 1301 – SCOP Subsection for local governments within the Everglades Agricultural Area (Dormant)**
- **DBE % Change – FDOT DBE goal was adjusted from 10.67% to 10.54%**

FY 2024-25 General Appropriations Act (Chapter 2024-231, Laws of Florida)

\$14.5 billion for the State Transportation Work Program

- **\$241,452,139 of the \$14.5 billion is earmarked by Specific Appropriation 2069A of the GAA for 55 Local Transportation Projects. Info sheets distributed to the Districts to assist with common issues: right of way, private entities, and matching funds/agreement preparation.**
- **\$9M is earmarked for transportation projects in municipalities related to the Small County Outreach Program (SCOP-M) pursuant to section 288.0656(7)(a).**

- Application Cycles usually open in the Fall and close in December. FDOT does not currently have a cycle open.
- Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will solicit REQUEST FOR FUNDING (RFF) projects by the Shared-Use Nonmotorized (SUN) Trail program for inclusion in the work program development cycle through Fiscal Years 2029 / 2030. Approved project phases will become part of the Adopted Work Program on July 1, 2025. To be eligible for consideration applicants must APPLY during the open solicitation cycle online at flgap.com by submitting a complete RFF with all applicable project information, including required signatures and documentation for each eligible unfunded project phase, and the SUN Trail Cost Estimate (Excel) through the Grant Application Process online system (GAP).

TA solicitation cycles vary by region. D5 is currently open. Other districts haven't announced the next one. Below is more recent info.

- District 2: Oct. 2, 2023 – Jan. 16, 2024, by 2:00 p.m. Hard deadline.
- District 3: Nov. 1, 2023 – Jan. 19, 2024, by 4:00 p.m. CST (5:00 p.m. EST) Hard deadline.
- District 4: Oct. 31, 2023 – Mar. 1, 2024, by 11:59 p.m. Hard deadline.
- **District 5: May 1, 2024 – Aug. 15, 2024, by 11:59 p.m. Hard deadline.**
- District 6: Nov. 6, 2023 – Dec. 6, 2023, by 5:00 p.m. Hard deadline.
- District 7: Dec. 18, 2023 – Mar. 15, 2024, by 5:00 p.m. Hard deadline.

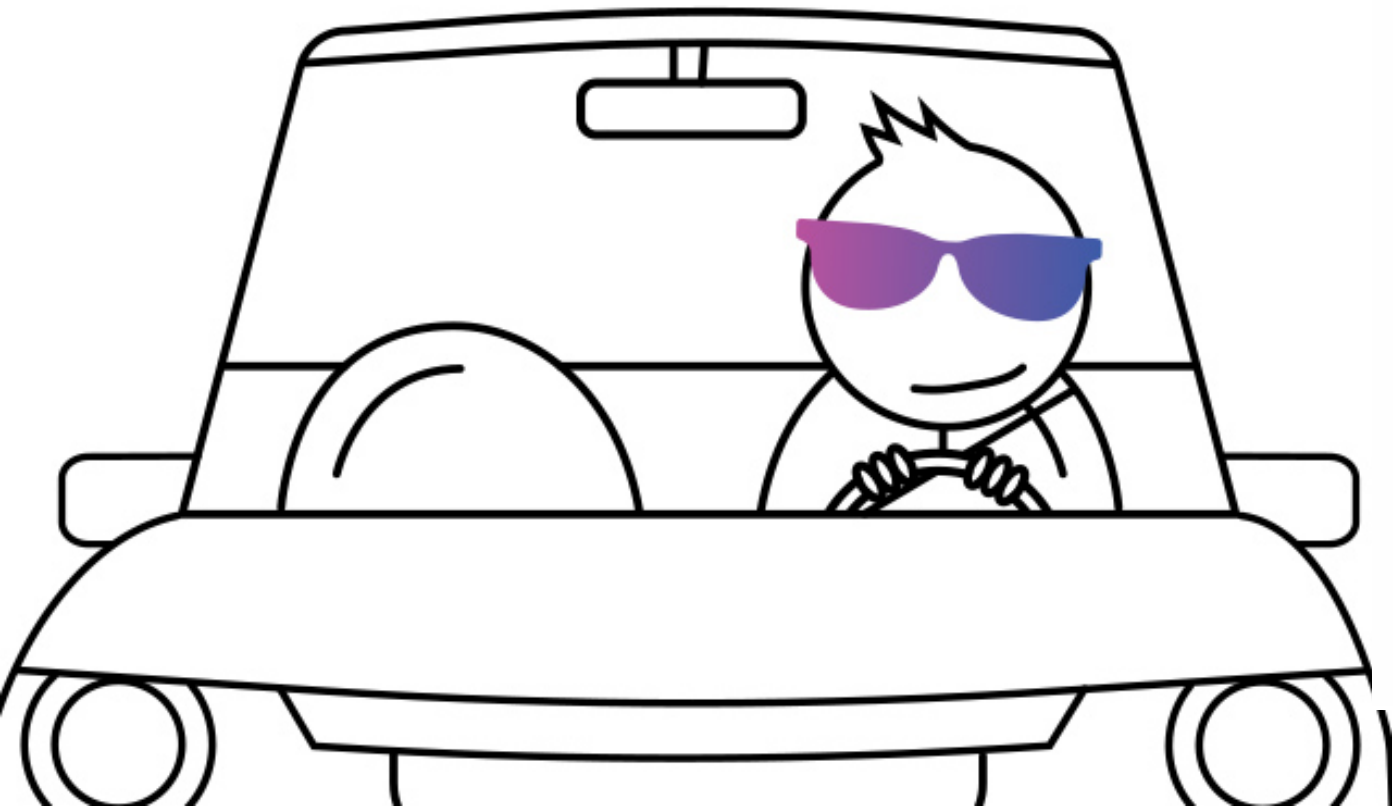
Highway Beautification Program
